

IEPMF Privacy Policy

IEPMF (hereinafter referred to as “the Foundation”) complies with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and other relevant laws and regulations, ensuring the proper management and operation of personal information.

1. Purpose of Use

The Foundation will use the personal information it acquires only within the scope of the following business purposes:

- Promotion and public awareness activities related to endoscopic medicine
- Education, training, and human resource development for physicians and medical professionals
- Introduction, lending, and operational support of endoscopy-related equipment and simulators
- Improvement, research and development, and performance evaluation of endoscopy-related devices
- Cooperation with academic societies, research meetings, and international joint projects
- Joint research and training programs with public and educational institutions
- Public awareness and information activities related to preventive medicine and early detection
- Other public interest activities as defined by the Foundation

The Foundation does not acquire or process medical records, clinical data, or other sensitive health information.

2. Restrictions on Provision to Third Parties

The Foundation will not provide personal information to third parties for the purpose of direct promotion, such as direct mailings or telemarketing.

However, personal information may be provided to contractors or partners (such as research institutions, joint project participants, or academic organizations) only to the extent necessary to achieve the Foundation’s business objectives. In such cases, the Foundation will require these contractors and partners to adhere to confidentiality obligations and implement security measures equivalent to those of the Foundation.

3. Provision Based on Laws and Regulations

Except as required by law, the Foundation will not provide personal information to third parties without the individual’s consent.

4. Data Storage and Security

Personal information acquired by the Foundation will be stored and managed on cloud servers located in Japan.

The Foundation implements appropriate technical and organizational security measures to prevent

unauthorized access, loss, destruction, alteration, or leakage of personal information.

By providing personal information to the Foundation, the individual consents to its storage and management in Japan.

5. Requests for Disclosure, Correction, etc.

When a request is made by an individual for the disclosure, correction, suspension of use, or other handling of their personal information, the Foundation will respond appropriately and promptly in accordance with the Act.

The International Endoscopic Preventive Medicine Foundation (hereinafter referred to as “IEPMF”) complies with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information and all other applicable laws and regulations. IEPMF appropriately manages and handles personal information in accordance with these standards.

IEPMF will use the collected personal information only within the scope of the following purposes:

- Improvement, research and development, and performance evaluation of endoscopy-related equipment

- Other public-interest activities as defined by the Institute

IEPMF does not collect or process medical records, clinical data, or other sensitive health-related information.

2. Provision to Third Parties

IEPMF will not provide personal information to third parties for direct marketing purposes, such as sending promotional materials or making telemarketing calls.

However, personal information may be shared with contractors or partner organizations (including research institutions, joint project collaborators, academic societies, and related organizations) to the extent necessary to achieve the above purposes.

In such cases, IEPMF will ensure that these parties maintain confidentiality and handle personal information with the same level of security as IEPMF.

3. Provision Based on Laws and Regulations

Except as required by applicable laws and regulations, IEPMF will not provide personal information to third parties without the individual’s consent.

4. Requests for Disclosure, Correction, or Suspension of Use

If an individual requests disclosure, correction, suspension of use, or any other handling of their personal information, IEPMF will respond promptly and appropriately in accordance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information.

5. Requests for Disclosure, Correction, or Suspension of Use

If an individual requests disclosure, correction, suspension of use, or any other handling of their personal information, IEPMF will respond promptly and appropriately in accordance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information.

6. Withdrawal of Consent

Individuals may withdraw their consent to the use of their personal information at any time. However, such withdrawal will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out based on consent prior to its withdrawal.
