

Privacy Policy and Consent Form

The International Endoscopic Preventive Medicine Foundation (hereinafter referred to as “IEPMF”) complies with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information and all other applicable laws and regulations. IEPMF appropriately manages and handles personal information in accordance with these standards.

Please read the following carefully and indicate your consent by selecting “I Agree.”

1. Purpose of Use

IEPMF will use the collected personal information only within the scope of the following purposes:

- Promotion and awareness activities related to endoscopic medicine
 - Education, training, and human resource development for physicians and healthcare professionals
 - Introduction, lending, and operational support of endoscopy-related devices and simulators
 - Improvement, research and development, and performance evaluation of endoscopy-related equipment
 - Cooperation in academic conferences, research meetings, and international collaborative projects
 - Joint research and training programs with public or educational institutions
 - Public awareness and promotional activities regarding preventive medicine and early detection
 - Other public-interest activities as defined by the Institute
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2. Provision to Third Parties

IEPMF will not provide personal information to third parties for direct marketing purposes, such as sending promotional materials or making telemarketing calls.

However, personal information may be shared with contractors or partner organizations (including research institutions, joint project collaborators, academic societies, and related organizations) to the extent necessary to achieve the above purposes.

In such cases, IEPMF will ensure that these parties maintain confidentiality and handle personal information with the same level of security as IEPMF.

3. Provision Based on Laws and Regulations

Except as required by applicable laws and regulations, IEPMF will not provide personal information to third parties without the individual’s consent.

4. Requests for Disclosure, Correction, or Suspension of Use

If an individual requests disclosure, correction, suspension of use, or any other handling of their personal information, IEPMF will respond promptly and appropriately in accordance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information.

5. Withdrawal of Consent

Individuals may withdraw their consent to the use of their personal information at any time.

However, such withdrawal will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out based on consent prior to its withdrawal.
